

GO FISH Games

To play the following math games, print 4 copies of number cards (pages 1-3).

GO FISH! (Number Match)

1. Deal 5 cards to each player. Cards should be held so they are able to see them but no one else can.
2. The remaining cards are placed face down in the middle of the players.
3. Before starting the game, all of the players take out any pairs (matching numbers) they have and place the cards in front of them.
4. The players then take turns asking one of their opponents "Do you have a ___?" The card requested should be one the player has in their hand to make a match.
5. If the opponent has the card, they must give it to the player. The player then takes the pair and places it in front of them.
6. If the opponent does not have the card they say "Go Fish!" and the player must then pick a single card from the face down pile of cards.
7. If a player runs out of cards, they pick five from the pile.
8. The person with the most number cards when the middle pile is all gone wins the game!

GO FISH 10s

To play GO FISH 10s, you will only need number cards 1-10 and wild cards (optional).

1. Deal 5 cards to each player. Cards should be held so they are able to see them but no one else can.
2. The remaining cards are placed face down in the middle of the players.
3. Before starting the game, all of the players take out any two numbers that are equal to 10 and place the cards in front of them.
4. The players then take turns asking one of their opponents "Do you have a ___?" The card requested should be the number the player needs to make a 10 (for example: If a player has 7, they need a 3 to make 10).
5. If the opponent has the card, they must give it to the player. The player then takes the pair and places it in front of them.
6. If the opponent does not have the card they say "Go Fish!" and the player must then pick a single card from the face down pile of cards.
7. If a player runs out of cards, they pick five from the pile.
8. The person with the most number cards when the middle pile is all gone wins the game!
